

DRESS CODE

Your school uniform confirms your attendance at Incarnation School and is a symbol of unity within the school community. It minimizes distractions in the learning process. It is important that you take pride in your appearance by wearing your complete uniform always remembering that by wearing it inside and outside the classroom and the school you are representing the school and your behavior should be a credit to both yourself and the school community. All students must wear the complete school uniform, purchased from the Scholastic Uniform Company, specified at all times. When an emergency situation arises and your child is sent to school out-of-uniform, parents are required to send in a note.

Boys and girls in grades K-5 have the option of wearing uniform shorts and polo shirts during the month of September thru October 15th and again beginning May 1st. Shorts and shirts purchased from the Scholastic Uniform Company are the only shorts and polo shirts that can be worn.

For all girls:

1. Make-up and colored fingernail polish are not permitted
2. Skirts must be worn at knee length
3. Hair must be of natural color with no extremes in styles
4. No visible tattoos or body piercing except for earrings (only 1 earring in each ear)
5. No pins on sweaters except pins supplied by the school
6. If a tee shirt is worn under the uniform shirt, it must be solid white
7. The presence of anything that proclaims a current fad is not permitted

For all boys:

1. Hair styles must be conservative – long hair (touching the collar; bangs that impede vision) or shaved hair styles with designs, mohawks, etc. are not permitted
2. Hair must be natural color
3. No earrings are permitted
4. No visible body piercing or tattoos permitted
5. If a tee shirt is worn under the uniform shirt, it must be solid white

Personal Appearance

A good personal hygiene routine should be followed daily: ears, neck, and fingernails should be given special attention. When appropriate, children should be instructed in the use of deodorant.

Uniforms should be clean, ironed and in good repair. Parents/guardians are asked to be aware of the way their child leaves for school each morning.

Hair should be clean and well groomed. The boys' hair should be conservative and not touch the shirt collar. Bangs should not be so long that they impede vision.

Parents will be notified if a child comes to school consistently in an unkempt manner. If no improvement is noticed within a reasonable amount of time, an appointment with the parents and with the guidance office will be made by school officials.
